Saw our great friends of many years and enjoyed the warmth away from Coronado. I was nominated and accepted my fourth three-year term as an Ambassador for the U.S. Army Reserve. I also serve as a member of The Chief of Staff of the Army Retiree Council.

During the annual conference in Chicago, we took a trip north to Great Lakes Naval Training where my mother Frances, my sister Yvonne and I lived from 1942 to 1945 while my father Myron, a

Chief Petty Officer, trained Sailors and was an assistant coach with the Great Lakes football and baseball team. We stayed at the Navy Lodge and visited familiar sites on the Navy Base which has changed greatly. We took a great tour of Oak Park and a visit to the Frank Lloyd Wright house where he lived and worked.

There were a number of fun and working trips to San Jose, Monterey, San Francisco, Moffett Field, Las Vegas and Phoenix during the year.

I had a week in North Carolina staying at the Pinehurst Golf and Resort while attending and participating in anti-terrorism training on the Combat Course. The "ninjas" that instructed us on the combat course at Ft. Bragg took us next door to the training site and headquarters for the U.S. Army parachute team the "Golden Knights" and we spent about two hours with them. I fired the AK-47 and a number of small arms, hitting the targets at 50 to 200 meters. The Combat Course has live fire and live munitions around the course including (IEDS) Improved Explosive Devices.

Judy and I, our daughters, Heidi and Jenny meet on a regular basis for trips to various events around San Diego and Los Angeles. All the families are doing well and keep busy. We are looking forward to a trip to DC and Chattanooga in April 2012.

BG Robert D. Upp – Last 63rd Assignment Staff Judge Advocate. General Upp stated that when you reach my age you spend a lot of time, reminiscing and reliving pleasant time in the past. Military duty can have strange effect upon some of us.

During WWII, I was made the Commander of five cross-country troop trains. Since then, it's been All Aboard with me. My first duty assignment was as a company commander in an Alabama replacement training center. After six months my commander called and asked if I would like to take charge of a troop train to San Luis Obispo. He knew I was from California and offered leave en route. With an old mess sergeant, we outfitted a baggage car as a kitchen and drew enough food for 200 men for five days. No problem except at a

morning stop in Yuma, the heat was 100 degrees plus, and I complained. The Sarge laughed and said it was no problem. He made bacon and eggs without lighting the stove. They cooked just from the heat in the car. Six months later, I was offered to lead a troop train to Los Angeles. It was easier. The QM took care of the kitchen and I was given a doctor and an assistant Commander to help.

Later, I volunteered for combat duty and was sent to a replacement center in Pennsylvania. There they put me in charge of a troop train to Seattle, where I was to ship out. On this trip, I just road along. From there I went to the Aleutians. Back from that session, I joined the 65th Division and was sent to Europe in Mid-Winter, and landed in the snow, rain and mud of France. We were shipped from there to Thionville, near the Belgium border, on a two day train ride in the French WWI 40 or 8 (40 men or 8 horses) cars. Most were on blankets on a straw covered floor. I had an eiderdown sleeping bag and inflatable air mattress from Alaska, so was comfortable.

When the war ended, I was on a select group to fly home. We took a train from Linz, Austria to Marseilles, France. We flew on a B-29 to Miami. En route, we stopped in Casablanca, Senegal, Brazil and Trinidad, using 30 days for the trip. My last Troop train to command was from Camp Blanding, FL to Los Angeles.

With the RR urge, I've ridden many trains since the wars. Jane and I rode the Trans-Siberian across Russia and Siberia. We railed across Australia from Adelaide to Perth. We rode a train in South Island, New Zealand, and had to stop for inspection when the engine hit a sheep. The Indian Express from Bombay to New Delhi was interesting, as we met a classmate of my daughter at a certain stop. We also took the Little Blue Train in Northeastern India up to Darjeeling in the Himalayas. In China, we were on an Express from Beijing to old Canton. It was overnight, with four people in each cabin. Two gays in the group asked to join us, as they said we were the only ones who would put up with them. In Africa, we took the Spectacular Blue Train from Pretoria to Cape Town. For the trip through the Mexican Copper Canyon, we had reserved seats for group of six. The locals

took all of our seats, but the conductor let us ride in the Caboose at the end and Jane and I rode in the cupola. The ride to Machu Piccu was a rare one, and we followed that with at Trans-Andean trip across Peru and into Bolivia. Those railroads were being rebuilt by a German firm and should now be in great shape.

Back in Europe, we have had month long Eurail Passes on 14 different summers. On one, Frank Prince and I decided to circle the Gulf of Bothnia, which lies between Sweden and Finland. That started with a Finn train, a nice Swedish cabin, and then with the help of a couple of ferries, down the Norwegian coast to meeting in Oslo. Jane and I rode an overnight train from Rome to Sicily, but she got sick from drinking water aboard. We did the Royal Scotch train from London to Scotland, and a slow steamer in the hills of Wales. It was a great Christmas ride in Ireland from Dublin to the Blarney Castle, where the Irishmen in the bar car kept us warm on Irish whiskey.

I've been to Alaska many times and have ridden their rails. A friend of mine, now deceased, was the Yardmaster when the tracks were Federal. He let me ride in the Engine on a couple of trips. The last one was from a WWII port, through a tunnel to Whittier. He let me drive the train in the tunnel, saying the only problem might be a wild moose. None appeared, so he made me an honorary engineer and gave me an Alaskan RR Cap to prove it.

My time may be short, but I may do the Canadian Rocky Mountain. The Road from China to Tibet would be too much. I'd love to experience the magnetic job that the Germans have built for the Chinese at the Shanghai airport. ALL ABOARD!!!

We again thank every one for your input into our *Whooze Nuze*. You are important to us. If you didn't have a message this year, we are looking for your message next year.
