Presidents Message

Colonel Steve Mogan USA Ret. who some may know from when he was the G3 for the 63d RRC/RSC or when he was with one of the subordinate units will present a briefing on "Defense Support of Civilian Agencies and the Army Reserve". Steve is the Chief of Operations for the Defense Coordination Element, Region IX headquartered in the Bay Area. California VETERAN License Plates

California VETERAN license plates are back by popular demand! Drivers now have the option of ordering either VETERAN or HONORING VETERANS license plates. Both plates can be customized with the distinctive military branch or veterans service organization logo of choice. That is great news for both veterans and veteran supporters. VETERAN plates can be reserved now but are not immediately available. According to the new law that authorized the plates,

CalVet must collect and hold pre-paid applications until 7,500 are received before DMV will actually produce the VETERAN plate. Once that threshold is crossed, DMV will produce the plates and take responsibility for processing future applications.
