As we all know being a member of the US Army is more than service to our country. It's belonging to a "band of brothers" that those who have never served will never really understand or fully appreciate.


I have often wondered what it was that motivated Soldiers to do the brave things that we recognize with awards like the Silver Star or the "V" Device?
